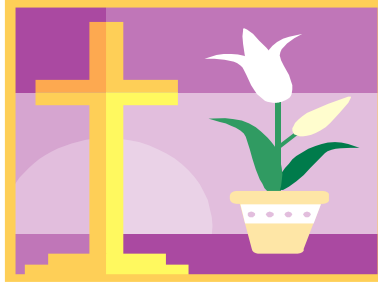


Kindergarten Newsflash March 25, 2010
