4SYMPTOMS?	FEVER?	GUIDELINE	PROOF OF TEST REQUIRED?
<p>MILD SYMPTOMS (infrequent cough, mild congestion, runny nose, sore throat)</p>	<p>NO FEVER (temperature less than 100.0 F without the aid of fever reducing medication such as Acetaminophen (Tylenol) or Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin))</p>	<p>TEST - GO</p> <p>Test first day of symptoms, if negative test, may report to school.</p> <p>If positive test see "symptoms + positive test" below)</p>	<p>Do not need to submit proof of negative test</p>
<p>RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS (persistent cough, head congestion, profuse runny nose, severe sore throat)</p>	<p>WITH FEVER (temperature greater than 100.1 degrees F or higher) or WITHOUT FEVER (temperature less than 100.0 F without the aid of fever-reducing medication such as Acetaminophen (Tylenol) or Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin))</p>	<p>STAY HOME until fever has resolved for a full 24 hours without the use of medications, and symptoms have resolved</p> <p>Testing recommended. If positive test, see "symptoms+positive test" below</p>	<p>Do not need to submit proof of a negative test</p>
<p>POSITIVE TEST WITH OR WITHOUT SYMPTOMS</p>	<p>WITH OR WITHOUT FEVER</p>	<p>STAY HOME IN ISOLATION (away from others, as possible) FOR A FULL FIVE DAYS. ("Day 1" is the day of the positive test result)</p>	<p>May report to school on "Day 6" with improvement of symptoms and wearing a mask through day 10.</p>
