If positive test see "symptoms + positive test" below)	Do not need to submit proof of negative test
<b>RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS</b> (persistent cough, head congestion, profuse runny nose, severe sore throat)	WITH FEVER (temperature greater than 100.1 degrees F or higher) or WITHOUT FEVER (temperature less than 100.0 F without the aid of fever-reducing medication such as Acetaminophen (Tylenol) or Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin)	<b>STAY HOME</b> until fever has resolved for a full 24 hours without the use of medications, and symptoms have resolved Testing recommended. If positive test, see "symptoms+positive test" below	Do not need to submit proof of a negative test
POSITIVE TEST WITH OR WITHOUT SYMPTOMS	WITH OR WITHOUT FEVER	STAY HOME IN ISOLATION (away from others, as possible) FOR A FULL FIVE DAYS. ("Day 1" is the day of the positive test result)	May report to school on "Day 6" with improvement of symptoms and wearing a mask through day 10.
