# Coffee &Conversation: Kids and Technology

- Upon conclusion of the regular meeting, we transitioned to our Coffee & Conversation series featuring guest speaker and technology expert Christopher Blackman.
- Laura Maher led the group in a prayer.
- Christopher Blackman presented "Risks of Social Media to Young Pre-teen Children: Understanding and Mitigating the Dangers."
  - o Christopher prepared a handout that included statistics and information regarding exposure to inappropriate content, the 2024 cyberbullying report, privacy

- concerns and financial extortion, addiction and screen time, social comparison and self-esteem.
- He also provided a list of some apps that parents can use to monitor and restrict their children's social media use. Finally, he provided some enhanced mitigation strategies.
